



**PEAR'S HOUSE**

**WALLS:** For a traditional feel and a touch of the old, walls are finished with a mix of brickwork and plaster. The brickwork is a mix of red and white, and the plaster is a light cream color.

**FLOORING:** The floors are finished with a mix of wood and stone. The wood is a dark oak, and the stone is a light grey granite.

**ROOFING:** The roof is finished with a mix of tiles and slate. The tiles are a mix of red and grey, and the slate is a dark grey.

**PAINTS:** The walls are painted in a mix of colors. The main walls are a light cream, and the accents are in shades of yellow, blue, and red.

**FINISHES:** The finishes are a mix of modern and traditional. The modern finishes include large windows and a mix of materials, while the traditional finishes include brickwork and plaster.
